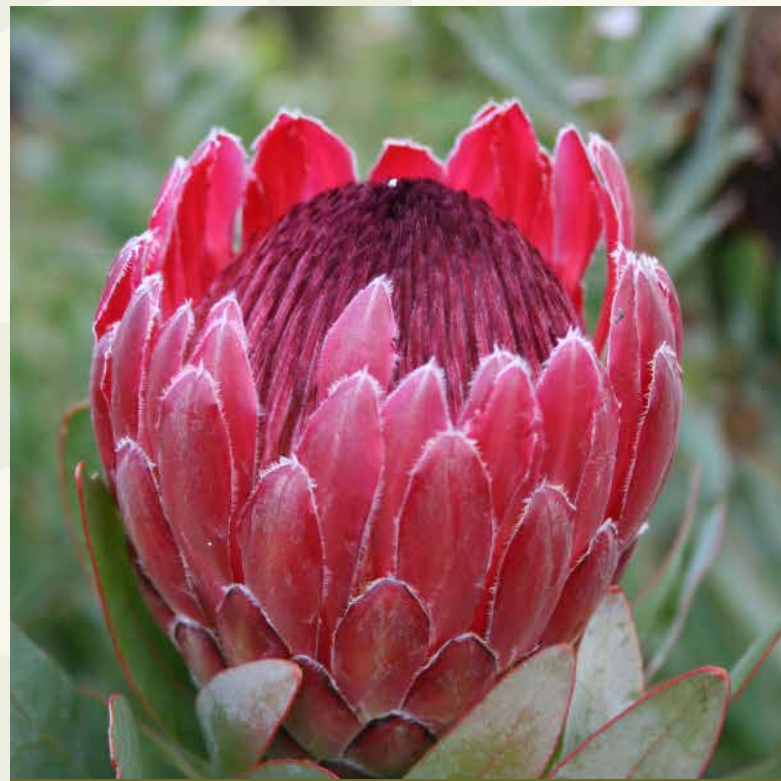

OUR FARMING PRACTICES

Sustainable Farming

Soil moisture meters guide precise irrigation to avoid water waste.



Experts monitor pests and diseases for effective, eco-friendly control.



Fertilisation is planned by experts using soil tests and growth stages.



Skilled Workforce & Operations

We use advanced technology for optimal growth and quality.

Trained staff handle all stages of protea fields, from planting to harvest.

Handling & Compliance

Our flowers are processed in a modern packhouse with top cooling facilities.

The farm complies with all audits and requirements regarding flower production.

Environmental Stewardship

We rehabilitate old orchards with fynbos to protect natural habitats. We remove alien plants and use them for mulch and compost.

Solar power runs the farm, with surplus sold to the grid. Our gravity-fed irrigation system needs no electricity.

Social Development

Tourism and the packhouse boost the local economy and support skill growth in the area.

The BOSJES Trust supports the local school, funding leadership, activities like music, sport, robotics, and upkeep of school grounds.



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
